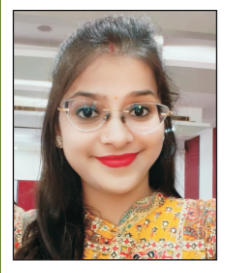


About the Author's

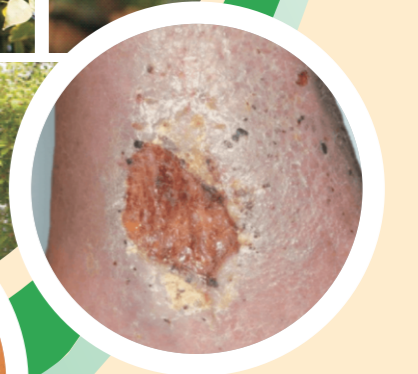
